The Kedumba Collection embodies and reflects all the elements of outstanding drawing created in Australia over more than twenty five years.

Since its inception in 1990, the Kedumba Collection has acquired over two hundred drawings. These have been sourced from the annual Kedumba Drawing Award, approved gifts from artists and other benefactors, and acquisitions by the Trustees and Director on behalf of the Collection. As a result of this unique approach, the collection is widely considered to be of outstanding significance and importance.

The diversity of work in this exhibition highlights just how varied the personal visions of different artists can be within a single discipline. Artists represented include Rick Amor, Elisabeth Cummings, Donald Friend, Nicholas Harding, Cherry Hood, John Olsen, Ben Quilty, Lloyd Rees, Jan Senbergs, Aida Tomescu and Michael Zavros.
