This workshop for adults is suitable for beginners and intermediate students | Some previous drawing experience is helpful

Draw inspiration from nature whilst learning the fundamental skills of drawing. Students are invited to take the time to investigate the incredible diversity of forms and textures found in the natural world.

Focus on observing and drawing natural objects brought into the studio, with the occasional use of reference photographs.

Participants will be shown a range of pencil techniques and encouraged to experiment with graphite pencils, combined with other media, to create interesting effects. This course is suitable for beginners and more experienced students as each person will be attended to individually.

The tutor will supply some materials. Students are to bring the materials as listed below:

A set of graphite pencils - at least a 4B and 6B and 8B pencil (Mars Lumograph are recommended)

10 sheets of A4 paper, can be recycled paper, one side must be blank | A selection of natural objects - bring at least three.

A4 sketch book with *white acid free cartridge paper* | A kneadable eraser AND a vinyl eraser (this is the standard eraser most of us use)

Note book and pen | Rag to clean hands | Mug

Sharon Muir is a professional visual artist, working with the fine art disciplines of drawing and painting. Her last two solo exhibitions were in response to ecological concerns, and her work has been selected for nationally recognised awards such as the Art Concerning Environment Award and the Silk Cut Award for Linocuts. She has travelled widely as a freelance art teacher and has taught workshops throughout Australia, including touring outback QLD and NSW for three years as part of the Flying Arts Team. She is an enthusiastic teacher with vast experience who enjoys nurturing the creativity of her students.
