10.00 – 11.30am Treading Lightly | Ages 5-8yrs | \$18 (\$15*)

Children will be led on a walk into the Gallery grounds before creating an artwork about where their feet have been! After making a tracing around our feet we will draw all the things that we did or might have walked across, thinking about the plants and creatures that we share our planet with. Maximum 8-10 children.

12.30 - 3.00pm Field of Flowers | Ages 7-13yrs | \$27 (\$24*)

Working with oil pastels and paint, the class will work collaboratively to create a large artwork representing a field of flowers. Students will follow Carleen's instructions on the number and type of marks and shapes to make before they move on to work on a new area. Communication, coordination, listening and looking will be essential. Children will need to think about how the marks they are making will add to what is already drawn to create the outcome of a field of flowers. When the artwork is completed each child will use a cardboard frame to select one or more sections to cut out, mount and keep. Maximum 12 children.

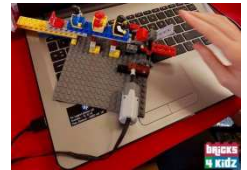
