ARTWORK CONDITIONS of ENTRY

- 2D entries MUST HAVE D-rings positioned 6cm below top of frame. Do not attach string/wire to D-rings
- For 3D entries, entrants must submit a .JPEG image up to 2MB with the filename as LASTNAME_Firstname_EntryTitle
- Entries MUST meet size and weight limits, must not have wet paint, unstable components, or consist of more than one piece. Entries that do not satisfy these conditions will not be accepted.
- Please deliver entry without packaging unless sent by courier.
- Late deliveries cannot be accepted under any circumstances.

BORDER ART PRIZE 2018 CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Please retain a copy of your ENTRY FORM, along with the CONDITIONS OF ENTRY and KEY DATES information for future reference.

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** The Border Art Prize 2018 is open to residents of the following council areas only: **Tweed, Ballina, Byron and Kyogle Shires, Lismore and Gold Coast City.**
2. **ENTRY** is limited to ONE entry only per artist. **Entry Fee is \$23.00** including GST and is not refundable in any circumstances. **Entry Form and Entry Fee must be received / submitted on-line by 5.00pm Friday 20 April 2018.**
3. Entry must have been completed since 1 May 2016, be an original artwork owned and created by the artist, not previously exhibited in the Council areas listed in Condition 1 including in other awards or prizes. Entry medium is open 2D or 3D, still media only. Theme is open.
4. **PRIZES** of \$3,000, \$1,500 and \$500 will be selected by the Judges and may be awarded to any work in any media. 2 x \$500 Shirley Kennedy Awards and 2 x \$250 Shirley Kennedy Encouragement Awards will be selected by Shirley Kennedy and the Gallery Director. The decision of the Judges is final and no discussion shall be entered into.
5. **The Border Art Prize 2018 will be exhibited over two venues: Tweed Regional Gallery, 2 Mistral Road, Murwillumbah South 2484 and M | Arts Precinct, 1 Brisbane Street, Murwillumbah 2484.** The exhibition venue for each entry is the decision of the Gallery and no correspondence will be entered into.
6. Depending on the number of entries received it may be necessary to pre-select artworks for exhibition due to space restrictions. The selection will aim to represent the range of media, genre and themes submitted. Only entries selected for exhibition are eligible for Prizes. The exhibition selection will be available online from 1.00pm Thursday 24 May at www.artgallery.tweed.nsw.gov.au
7. Entries not selected for exhibition may be collected on 24, 25 or 27 May, 10.00am - 4.00pm, or during the collection period in KEY DATES.
8. Entry must be identified on the back or base, or on a secured tag, with artist's name, phone number and entry title. Entries will be subject to multiple handling. The Gallery will take due care but entrants accept the risks involved. **The Gallery reserves the right not to display any entry which does not comply with these conditions.** If you are unsure, please discuss your entry with the Gallery before lodging your entry form or delivering your entry as unsuitable, unsafe or non-compliant works will not be accepted
9. **2D ENTRY: SIZE, WEIGHT and PRESENTATION:**
Maximum size: 105cm high x 105cm wide x 10cm deep, maximum weight: 15kg presented as ONE piece only including frame and any mixed media elements. A diptych / triptych can be accepted if it is framed as one work. **Entry must be framed, ready to hang on the wall, with D-rings attached 6cm from top of frame. Do not attach wire to D-rings.** A stretched canvas is considered framed. Frame must be strong and secure or it will not be hung.
10. **3D ENTRY: SIZE, WEIGHT and PRESENTATION**
Maximum size: 150cm high x 70cm x 70cm footprint, presented as ONE piece only, free standing, stable and fully assembled, suitable and safe for public display on a plinth or standing on the floor. Maximum weight: 20kg, must be able to be lifted and moved safely and easily by one person. For 3D entries please submit a JPEG photograph of artwork to AwardsAndPrizes@tweed.nsw.gov.au to aid in selection of the exhibition venue for delivery.
11. **DELIVERY OF ARTWORK:** Entries must be delivered to Tweed Regional Gallery, unless advised otherwise, during the times listed in the KEY DATES section. Deliveries cannot be accepted outside these times. Please deliver your work without any packaging unless essential for safekeeping or return by courier. All transport costs, arrangements and insurance to and from the Gallery are the responsibility of the entrant. 3D entrants will be advised by email if they are required to deliver to M | Arts Precinct.
12. The official **OPENING and ANNOUNCEMENT OF WINNERS** will be held at **M | Arts Precinct**, on Saturday 26 May from 5.00 - 7.00pm. The Gallery will attempt to contact prize winners prior to the opening event.
13. All entries MUST state either the retail price (where artwork is for sale) or wholesale price (if not for sale). All art sales are subject to 33% Gallery commission including GST. Eg. \$100 retail = \$67 wholesale to the artist and \$33 commission to the Gallery, incl. GST. Entrant must submit an invoice for payment.
14. **COLLECTION OF ARTWORK:** Entries must be collected during the times listed in the KEY DATES section. Exhibited entries may not be removed prior to these times. Entries not collected within these times will be disposed of. For return of entries by carrier/post entrants must: Clearly mark entry form with instructions for return | Supply reusable packaging, address labels and completed consignment forms or postage | Supply courier with details of item to be collected including the name of the artist and Gallery Hours.
15. **PHOTOGRAPHY and MEDIA:** Exhibited entries may be reproduced in print and electronic media, including, but not limited to, exhibition catalogues, entry forms, information sheets and social media for the purposes of publicity and promotion of the Border Art Prize and Tweed Regional Gallery.
16. The Gallery reserves the right to make the final decision in respect of any issue relating to the organisation and administration of the 2018 competition.
